Instructional Observation Coaching Certificate candidates will have the skills to surface and address issues of equity in the classroom.

Teachers, coaches or current administrators who:



Are in or have access to a coaching relationship, or use coaching skills to improve supervisory relationships



Have a valid California Clear teaching credential

Instructional Coaching: Observation-Based Cycles  
(Reach 420; 2 units)

Coaching for Equity and Universal Access  
(Reach 440; 2 units)

Participate in 2 Coaching Cycles (Reach 470; 1 unit)

Pass the Reach Coaching Performance Assessment

## Cost:

**\$1,000** per individual course (no certificate)

**\$2,750** for the coaching certificate  
(2 courses, coaching cycles, performance assessment and units)
